

Did you know that...

- There are 104,074 shopping centers in the United States. The vast majority of shopping centers (98.6%) are open-air centers.
- California has the most shopping centers – 13,764
- Wyoming has the least – 59
- In 2009, there were 624 more shopping centers operating in the United States than in 2008
- There were approximately 1,394 enclosed malls in 2009 in the United States
- Currently, the average enclosed mall contains 952,603 square feet of total floor space
- In 2009, shopping center sales totaled \$2.25 trillion
- Shopping center sales generated \$118.1 billion in state sales tax revenue in 2009
- Shopping center-related employment totaled 12.4 million jobs in 2009
- Supermarkets are the most common anchor in open-air centers
- Apparel and accessories stores account for 53.8% of all non-anchor mall space
- Southdale Center in Edina, Minnesota, opened in 1956 as the first fully enclosed mall in the United States.
- Walmart was the highest grossing retailer in 2009 generating \$404.4 billion in sales
